The Stakeholders feedback report has been placed in the academic council meeting

As a continuous process of stakeholders' Feedback, the Report of feedback has been taken to the

Academic Council Meeting of the Institution. The stakeholders' involvement in the institution makes it

more social and responsible. It is traditionally seen as the institution's responsibility in action.

In the meeting, the stakeholders' feedback report was discussed. Though 95% of the students have registered their opinion in positive point, the remaining 5% was the main content of the meeting. IQAC coordinator explained the feedback result. Curriculum implementation or delivery methods were discussed and few new methods have been suggested especially for slow learners. Since the faculty feedback bearing the suggestions regarding curriculum updating, it has been discussed and the members of the board of studies were requested to take a message to BOS. Stakeholder's feedback has been analyzed. As they have asked, the council members have agreed to give concentration in competitive examination skills and said that the curriculum can be combined with it. Council members were asked to give their suggestions for further improvement. They conveyed their expectation on curriculum implementation and improvement in teaching by using ICT Tools which can help in innovative methods. The members of council said that the change that is likely to occur in teaching methodology reflects the broader change in the students' understanding. IQAC has suggested introducing add-on courses for the students to specialize them in their interest area. Stakeholders' engagement can therefore be expected as the process of effectively eliciting the stakeholders' views on their relationship with the institution. Gaining the capacity to handle them before they develop a negative vibe in the community. This will include avoiding negative press releases. The meeting increases the effectiveness which will result in more effective and efficient practice and high quality input within the institution. It enhances the two-way communication skills and better understanding on both sides and thereby bridges the cultural gaps. Finally It develops a culture of innovation and learning, for example by building the knowledge into our decisions and practices. Simplifies the conflict resolution through building trust, and a clearer articulation of what cannot be resolved.
