Tree Plantation

INTRODUCTION

It helps in reducing the symptoms of fever like headache, body aches, muscleaches, loss of energy, fatigue, weakness etc, Treats bacterial and viral infections.

The Nilavembu Kudineer programme was organized to create an awareness among the village people on 22.12.2020. The programme took place in Tiruppattur, Vairavanpatti, Tiruvudaiyarpatti, Yeriyoor, Vairavanpatti, Keeranipatti, Pattamangalam, Malampatti, Kootaiyoor, Singampunarai. The objective of this programme is to promote good health among the village people and protect them from flus. The motive of this event is to bring awareness about the event amongst the young students and to take care of their neighboring village people. 18 students were involved in this programme at various places and students went door to door to campaign the benefits of Nilavembu Kudineer. Students were present during the event. They also stressed the importance of this herbal tonic and urged the people to consume the tonic thrice a week. DENGUE AWARENESS

dengue possesses a serious disease which can drastically reduce the immunity of a person by reducing the platelets count in one's body. It can often be fatal. Many cases of deaths have been reported from all around the country, Dengue, frankly, cannot be prevented by giving vaccine, but its propagation can be controlled through awareness campaign among the public. Dengue fever is transmitted through mosquitoes and the mosquitoes breed in the stagnant water. Peoples simply don't dispose the waste water properly. As a result, stagnation of water takes place in their residing areas. Dengue organized at Kaaraiur Camp, Katampur, awareness program was Vairavanpatti on 22.12.2020. Preliminary, staff members educated the students about dengue infection, symptoms, modes of transmission and precautions, modes of treatment, solid waste, management, and maintenance of personal hygiene. Six students went door to door to create an awareness about Dengue. Later, cleaning drive was started at the afternoon on the same day. Students were provided gloves and plastic bags. The road sides and school campus have been swept and all plastic bags, plastic materials were removed and carefully disposed in the dustbin. The materials which can hold the rain water was also removed.

Outcome of the Program:

The Dengue Awareness program conducted on 22.12.2020 in N. Vairavanpatti, Kattampur, and Karaiyur Camp, spearheaded by students K. Karpagam, K. Keerthiga, K. R. Nandhini, S. Nandhini, S. Sangavi, and S. Sivetha (with respective enrollment numbers 0519103018, 0519103022, 0519103028, 0519103029, 0519103036, and 0519103044) aimed at educating communities about Dengue prevention and control, yielded commendable outcomes. Through interactive sessions and dissemination of information about the symptoms, transmission and preventive measures against Dengue fever the program succeeded in

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raising awareness among residents. By empowering locals with knowledge about mosquito breeding sites, proper waste disposal, and personal protection measures such as using mosquito nets and repellents, the initiative contributed to reducing the risk of Dengue outbreaks in the targeted areas. The proactive involvement of the students not only demonstrated their commitment to public health but also fostered a culture of community engagement and proactive disease prevention. People can reach the spot at the earliest possible of the threat when the app is used. Moreover, at times of natural disaster with the help of this app publican seek the help of the police. They were also educated to give a clear view about the App download so that they may explain it in their campaign.

Students were briefed to download and activate the Kavalan App by providing some basic informatiom. It has been vividly explained and the students were very clear of its necessity and its function.

The Kavalan home screen will be displayed on your mobile phone. Students were asked to brief the village people about "how to use the app'. Our staff members explained the process of operating the app. During an emergency, please press the SOS button on the home page. It will start a 5 second count down. After 5 seconds, the app will automatically send your current location along with a video from your back camera to the Kavalanteam. Within a minute, the team will contact you. Simultaneously, your location will also be sent to your registered emergency contacts as an SMS alert

The Kaavalan App awareness programme was initiated with the help of the students to create an awareness among the village people to protect themselves during emergency.

PROGRAM FOR SCHOOL TEACHERS (SAMAGRA SHIKSHA ABHIYAN) PROGRAMME REPORT

Due to the pandemic situation, all educational institutes were forced to rely on online platforms for academic and administrative purposes. School and college teachers were not that much exposed to various digital platforms. Administrative officials found difficult to get data from other institutes. In this connection, vocational education (software development) organized an outreach programme on Google Drive & Google Spreadsheets in nearby Block Development Resource Office, Thiruppathur on 30.11.2020 under Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan. Mr. R. Ayyalu, BRC Officer, welcomed the gatherers. Sixteen School teachers in Thiruppathur taluk were the participants. Dr. R. Kalidoss, Nodal Officer, Vocational Programme delivered special address. In his address, he highlighted the importance of digital platforms for exchanging information and communication. Mrs. A. Nirmala, Assistant Professor enlisted the various platforms available in the web. She elaborated in detail about the working ways in google drive regarding uploading and downloading the files. She listed out the various techniques involved in excel files also. She explained about sorting of data, filtering, arrangement, removing duplication, alignment of data, saving options and other techniques in excel. She highlighted about the advantages of using excel over PowerPoint. Students of vocational stream demonstrated the procedure regarding google drive and excel in the projector. Finally, hands on training were also given to the participants in the laptops.

In conclusion, the outreach program effectively addressed the digital literacy needs of educators in the face of the pandemic-induced shift towards online education. It fostered a deeper understanding of digital platforms like Google Drive and Excel, empowering participants with practical tools and techniques to enhance their administrative and academic endeavours. Extension Activity Report-2020-21

Extension activity provides a link between the College and the Society. In order to create socially sensitive citizens, the second year students are made aware of the common extension activities through department specific extension activities during the Induction Programme at the commencement of each academic year.Staff members and students of all the department of Arumugam Pillai Seethai Ammal College adopted villages in an endeavour to carry out welfare measures to the people of surrounding village. During the pandemic situation Department of History carried one day extension activity at Tirupathur nearby villages such as Thiruvudayarpatti, Madhvarayanpatti, and Kottampatti on 23.11.2020. In the programme 41 students of our department effectively participated with the social view and voluntarily involved in covid awareness programme. Our staff member divided the students into three groups. Each group members were allocated with aparticular area for various programmes such as covid awareness, tree plantation in schools, distributed nilavembu kudineer. The village people understand the source of corana, the symptoms of corana and how to make natural medicines (Nilavembu and Leaves of Papaya tree) to recover the health. In the programme 15 boys, 26 girls and from our department effectively participated with the social view and voluntarily involved. Our students insisted to the public on how to maintain cleanliness in and around village.

OUTCOME OF THE PROGRAM:

The one-day extension activity conducted by the Department of History at Tirupathur and nearby villages such as Thiruvudayarpatti, Madhvarayanpatti, and Kottampatti on 23.11.2020 yielded impactful outcomes amidst the pandemic situation. With the participation of 41 students, the program focused on raising awareness about COVID-19 and implementing various welfare measures in collaboration with the adopted villages. Divided into three groups, students actively engaged in activities such as COVID-19 awareness campaigns, tree plantation drives in schools, and distribution of Nilavembu Kudineer. Through these efforts, villagers gained knowledge about the source and symptoms of the coronavirus, as well as methods for natural healing using Nilavembu and Papaya tree leaves. The participation of 15 boys and 26 girls from the department underscored their commitment to social responsibility and community welfare. Moreover, students emphasized the importance of maintaining cleanliness in and around the villages, contributing to overall health and hygiene awareness. By fostering collaboration between the college and society, the extension activity not only served as a platform for student engagement but also empowered villagers with valuable information and resources for combating the pandemic and promoting well-being.

They also explained the various e-resources or e materials in the web and also elaborated the steps for downloading the materials. They also taught the students regarding how to login to any e-learning platforms such as Zoom Google meet etc., Our students assisted them and created mail id for the school children. Our students were also involved in tree plantation. They planted saplings in the school where they studied higher education and also in their own street. Besides the plantation, students also constructed plant guard in order to avoid gracing. They also cleaned the school campus and disposed the leaf debris, plastic materials and other unwanted materials out of the campus. Trees such as Neem, Mango, Asoka, cassia etc., were planted.

Awareness program related to pandemic situation was given to the village people. Since the public had to face the crucial situation of COVID-19, they were in depressed days. To make their mind stable and relaxed, our students make them aware of the financial crises and taught them to handle the situation and be peaceful. They convinced by telling them that this newly infectious disease can be controlled by allopathy medicines and also by taking vaccines. They urged the village people to take vaccines which is the only hope to eradicate the Covid-19. They also taught them methods how to sanitize and maintain social distance.




