A short message from Police of Tamilnadu was briefed to the students which will help the students in their campaign. People residing in Tamil Nadu, especially, Women and elderly people can use the Kavalan whenever they feel vulnerable or threatened. People can reach the spot at the earliest possible of the threat when the app is used. Moreover, at times of natural disaster with the help of this app public can seek the help of the police. They were also educated to give a clear view about the App download so that they may explain it in their campaign.

#### **How to Activate the App**

Benefits and methods of activating the app was explained to the students by our staff members to the students.

Students were briefed to download and activate the Kavalan App by providing some basic information.

- Personal Mobile Number
- Home Address
- Alternate Mobile Number
- E-mail Address
- Date of Birth
- Gender

- Details such as Mobile Number, Name & Relationship of any two relatives or close friends as emergency contacts, preferably living in the same city.
- Additionally, a third contact as an emergency contact may also be added.

After entering the above details, you will receive an activation code on your registered mobile number. Please enter your activation code to complete the registration process. The Kavalan home screen will be displayed on your mobile phone. Students were asked to brief to the village people about “how to use the app”. Our staff members explained the process of operating the app. During an emergency, please press the SOS button on the home page. It will start a 5 second count down. After 5 seconds, the app will automatically send your current location along with a video from your back camera to the Kavalan team. Within a minute, the team will contact you. Simultaneously, your location will also be sent to your registered emergency contacts as an SMS alert. The Kavalan App awareness programme was initiated with the help of the students to create an awareness among the village people to protect themselves during emergency.

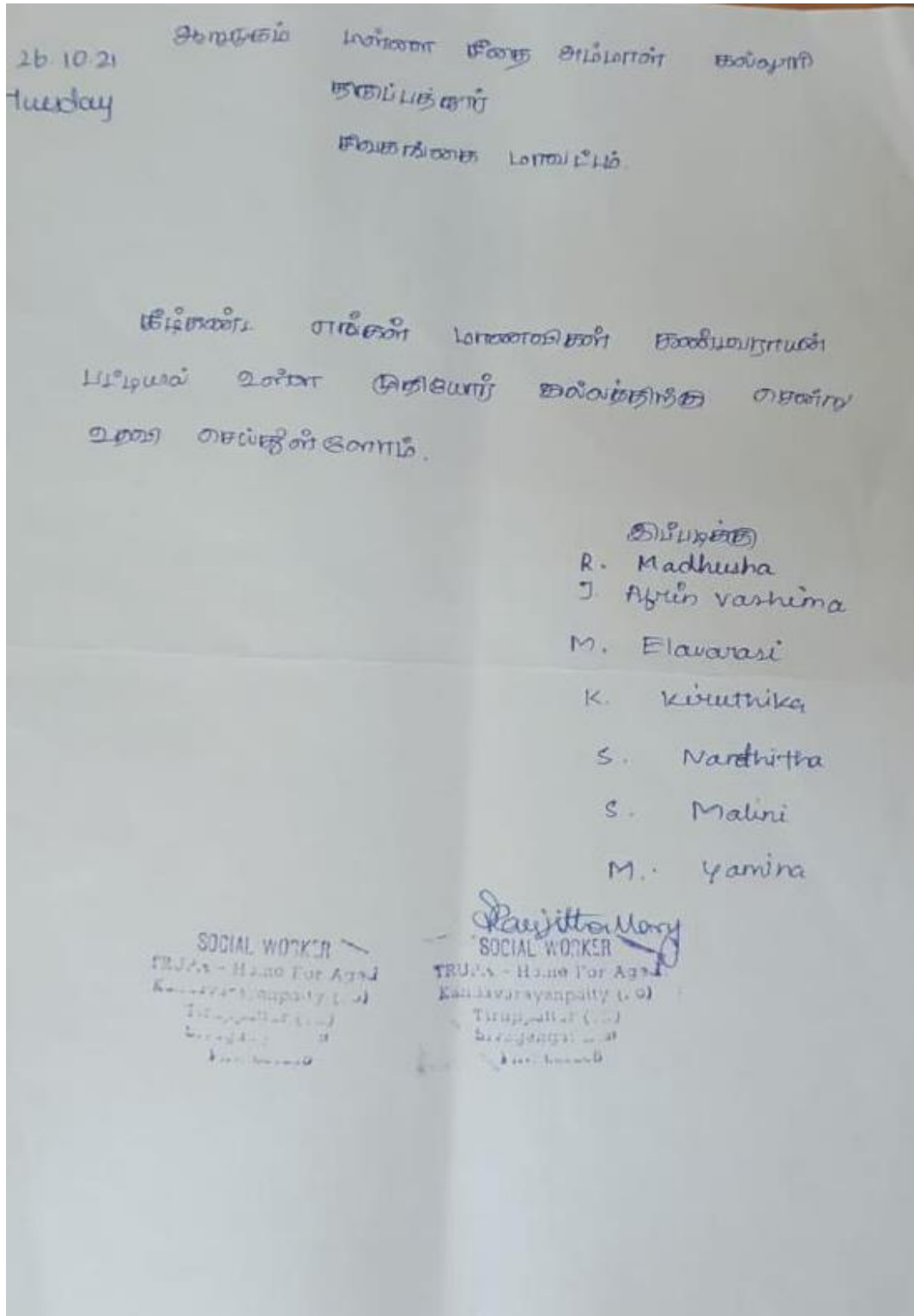

### **ACADEMIC YEAR 2021 – 2022**

#### **OBJECTIVE:**

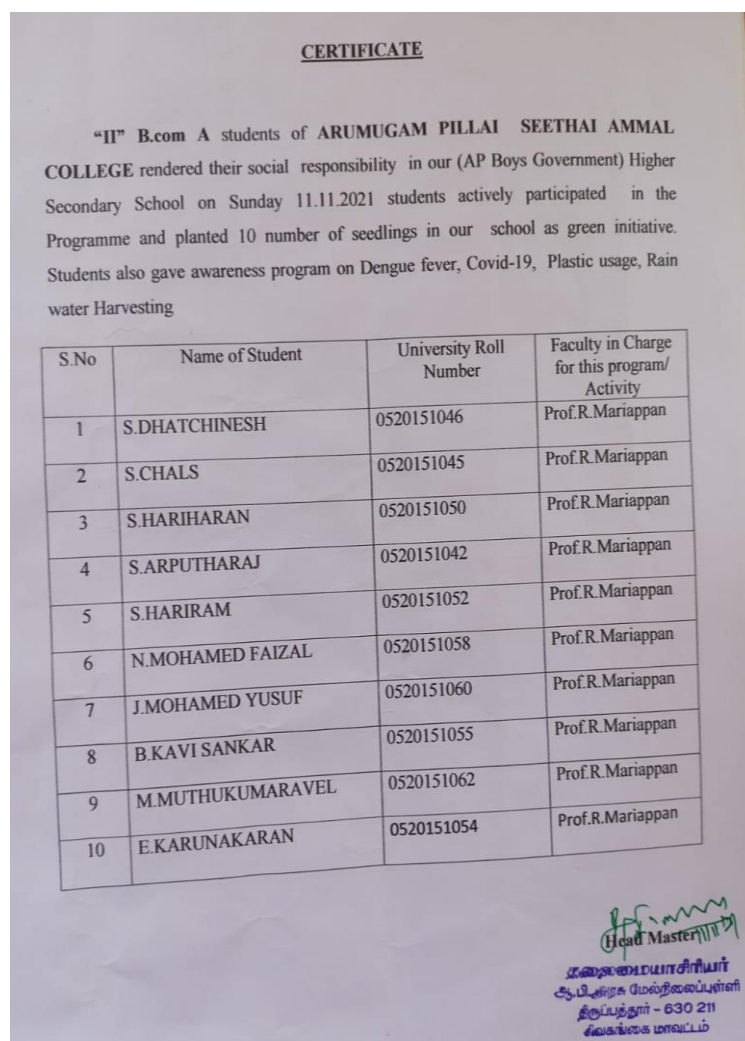

**Activity -Tree plantation:** Tree plantation is good for the environment. Everyone knows that trees are the source of oxygen. They inhale carbon dioxide and exhale oxygen without which the survival of living beings is not possible on earth. Trees also provide us with many benefits necessary for survival, including clean air, filtered water, shade, and food. Also, deforestation is a cause for global warming and creates many climatic imbalances. The planting trees are little things that students can do. So, the tree plantation is very essential for the current situation.

**Activity -Covid-19 Awareness:** The impact of the extension activity of our students is to make school students and the people aware and know more about the Covid-19. On that day, our students distributed the pamphlets to the people about the symptoms and prevention measures taken for Covid-19. The disease has a sudden on-set symptoms may include, fever, cough, body pain, loss in the sense of smelling and tasting, The pamphlet insists people to do prevention activities such as maintaining of social distance, mask wearing and vaccination. The students are quite interested in doing good things to the people and they were motivated by the joy and kindness of the people shown to them.

**Activity -Kavalan SOS app:** It is an app brought out by the Tamil Nadu police as part of its Master Control Room initiative. It will enable users to alert the police immediately during emergency situations such as sexual assault, kidnap or ‘eve teasing’ and natural disasters such as earthquake or floods. It can also be used in situations when the user is trapped unexpectedly, such as in an elevator or a toilet, and is unable to contact anyone. Students educate the public about the application. They show the application demo for downloading and working.

## **Extension Activity- Report**

### **Activity 1: POSHAN ABHIYAAN**

Under PoshyanAbhiyaan Scheme, Department of History, Red Ribbon Club and Department of Botany of our college and Nehru Yuvabharatham Welfare Association jointly organized an outreach programme from 23.09.2021 to 24.09.2021 at PrabhasSelviMahal, Thiruppathur. PoshanAbhiyaan programme is government of India's flagship programme to improve nutritional outcomes for children, pregnant women, and lactating mothers. On 23.09.2021, two faculty members along with eighteen II BA history girl's students actively participated and assisted the people. ThiruShanmuganathan, Director of Nehru Yuvabharatham Welfare Association, gave the welcome address. Mr.P.V.Praveenkumar, District Youth Officer, Nehru Yuva Kendra, inaugurated the programme. He highlighted the importance of this programme by focussing on nutritional status of adolescent girls, pregnant women, lactating mothers, and children from 0-6 year's age. He also insisted that this programme can be reached to all the corners of our nation only through community participation. This can be tasted success only through active participation of the students. Ms. R. Ananthi, Counsellor, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme, Sivagangai district, enlisted the various strategies to the parents which should be followed to raise the children's. She also stressed that psychological parents should be ready to bring out their children's in a healthy manner. Later, our students facilitated the programme by distributing the nutritional kit to the beneficiaries by packing the necessary ingredients inside the packet and ensured safety precaution while distributing the packets. Students also interacted with the beneficiaries about the importance of nutrition in every stage of growth. They particularly stressed the pregnant women to take healthy diet as they alone require 300gms of extra calories for effective strengthening of the bone. This can only be supplemented through a balanced diet of proteins, calcium, iron, and whole grains. In this aspect, apple, orange, guava, pomegranate fruits were packed and distributed to the beneficiaries. Similarly, students also gave some tips to adolescent girls to take iron rich foods such as dates, pomegranate etc., in their normal diet to avoid anemia conditions. Finally, Dr. T. Dhanalakshmi, Head, Department of History gave special address. She also insisted that all the women, who act as different roles in every stage of life, are vulnerable to health diseases. To avoid those circumstances, all women should give top priority to health conditions which can only met by nutritional diets. Finally, one of our student proposed a vote of thanks.

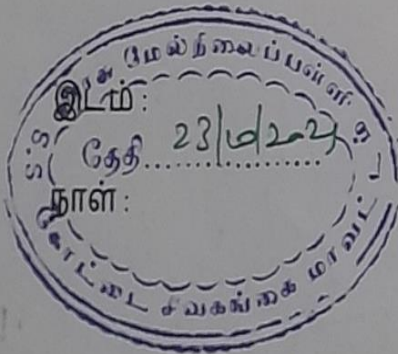

Saplings are young trees with a diameter of 1 to 5 inches at a point that is 4½ feet from the ground. Saplings may be balled and burlapped, bareroot, or containerized.

1. Choose a good spot for your tree.
2. Keep the roots moist all the time. Dry roots die.
3. Check for underground gas and utility lines before you dig
4. Plant the tree at the right depth. In nature, tree roots begin at or just beneath the soil surface, and so should your newly planting sapling.
5. Mulch with wood chips. Place chips 3 to 4 inches deep and spread from trunk out to drip line.
6. Remove any synthetic labels and tags.
7. Water the tree.

The above instructions are given by the staff members to the team. Our Part of II year students are going to the Kariyur village and effectively participated “the program on maintained the saplings program” They do successfully implemented to the village people.


